Quality Counts verification will be required for all youth exhibiting livestock (market and/or breeding) at major livestock shows in Texas. Tarrant County Livestock Show also requires every exhibitor to become verified. The verification process will require junior exhibitors to pass an online test that measures their knowledge on quality assurance and character education content items. Youth are able to go online to take the test and become verified. A verification number will need to be provided at the time of making an official entry into a Texas major livestock show. Thus, youth will need to have completed and passed the test before the major livestock show's entry deadline as well as the Tarrant County entry deadline. A passing score has been determined to be 80%. Students are only required to pass this test one time and their number will last until they complete their show career. The only exception is junior 4-H and FFA members, once a student turns 14 they must re-take the test and pass the senior test to become verified again.
